About Abstracts

Abstracts will be reviewed on a rolling basis, ending on **1 August, 2019**. To submit an abstract, you must confirm your assistance first by replying to the invitation email.

Please read the following guidelines carefully before preparing your abstract, and ensure all contact information is accurate while completing the registration process. Once you submit your abstract you should receive a confirmation email. All abstracts must be prepared according to the submission guidelines and using the abstract templates provided below:

- Abstracts can only be submitted on word format and online at connect@drisabelfranco.com or investwisely@gmail.com
- Abstracts must be submitted in English or Spanish
- Abstracts should not be more than 200 words
- No references, tables or graphics should be included in the abstract
- When using abbreviations within the body of the abstract, please spell out the name in full at first mention and follow with the abbreviation in parenthesis.
- It is the responsibility of the author to ensure abstract text does not contain any typos or grammatical errors. eWisely will not be responsible for any errors published.
- No changes can be made after the abstract deadline has passed.
- Make sure, you include affiliation, name, title and six keywords

About Presentations

- Presenters should include a two minute video briefly introducing themselves and the topic to be presented. The video is meant to be included at the beginning and before the recorded presentation.
- Presenters are encouraged to use the PPT template forwarded in the email and record presentations using Skype or Zoom. Presentations should not be more than 20 minutes long. Recorded presentations should be submitted to investwisely@gmail.com or connect@drisabelfranco.com before **15 August, 2019**.
